## **Subscriptions for 2022**

It was agreed at our last AGM to increase the annual subscription to £125 as of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 (discounted to £100 if paid before 30<sup>th</sup> June). This will allow the estate to start building up a 'sinking fund' in the event that a major repair is needed - we already know that tarmac needs to be replaced on some roads for example.

We are really hoping that every house owner pays as this money is used to cover the costs of maintaining roads, surface water sewers and gullies, side paths and grass verges. Without your subscriptions we cannot pay for work to be done on the estate and, over time, the estate will deteriorate. Details of how to pay have already been circulated. ## Treasurers' Report – April 2021 – March 2022

For the year 2021-22 we received subscriptions from 125 subscribers.

The Association had £17920.05 cash in the bank as of 31st March 2022.

During the financial year 2021-2022 we spent a total of £5033.38 of which:

- £3358.04 was spent on estate maintenance (grass and verge cutting, signage, fencing, road resurfacing) and
- £1675.34 was spent on administration (website, Dropbox data storage, legal advice and land registry maps)
